<b>Course Description:</b>	This course provides training on and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the ICS. The course expands upon information covered in the ICS 100 and ICS 200 courses.	
<b>Who Should Attend:</b>	Individuals who may assume a supervisory role in expanding incidents of Type 3 incidents. Also EOC staff personnel (FY07 NIMS Requirement).	
<b>Course Cost:</b>	This is a free course.	
<b>Prerequisite:</b>	<b>ICS-100 and ICS-200</b>	
<b>Reimbursements:</b>	<u>Eligible</u> participants living more than 50 miles from the course location will be reimbursed the cost of lodging and meals at the current state reimbursement rate. Hotel reservation and reimbursement information will be provided along with a course acceptance letter. Participants living more than 110 miles away may qualify for lodging the night before.	
<b>To apply:</b>	Complete SCEMD course application form (PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY). All municipal, county and special purpose/public service district applications require signatures from the County Emergency Manager/Director. Other applicants must have the signature of their immediate supervisor. Mail or fax to SCEMD Training. Applicants selected to attend the course will be notified by fax, letter or email three weeks prior to course date.
