Situation

1. SCEPD continues to monitor and respond to formal assistance requests through our 24-hour State Warning Point and Duty Officer.
2. SCEPD continues to work with donations issues as required. At this time, New York has no unmet needs for donated goods or services. The point of contact on the SCEPD staff regarding donations is Patrice Burns, Individual Assistance Coordinator, Recovery and Mitigation Section. As of today, SCEPD has documented 114 offers of assistance.
3. The International Association of Emergency Managers (IAEM) has made available, via e-mail, a copy of the FEMA Congressional and Intergovernmental Advisory #25 (situation report) as of September 24, 2001 for both the New York and Virginia (Pentagon) disasters. These advisories have been retransmitted for subscribers to the SC Emergency Management Forum (forum moderator is Ken Harrell, Dorchester EPD). The on-line version of these advisories is available at www.iaem.com. A hard copy (seven pages long) of the FEMA Congressional and Intergovernmental Advisories (NY and VA) #25 is also available by calling the State Warning Point and asking that they fax to you the FEMA Advisory #25.
