Catawba Nuclear Station (CNS) EVACUATION OF SPECIAL FACILITIES

I. INTRODUCTION

There are special facilities such as institutions, industries, amusement parks and similar entities located within the 10-mile (Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) that generally have a large concentration of transient population.

II. PURPOSE

To outline evacuation procedures for special facilities within the 10-mile EPZ in the event of a radiological incident at the CNS.

III. SITUATION

- A. Populations at these special facilities vary from 1,000 to 50,000.
- B. Two major special facilities in York County are Carowinds theme park and Winthrop University.
 - 1. Carowinds theme park is comprised mostly of transients. Transients living within the 10-mile EPZ will be considered part of the 10-mile EPZ population. The remainder of the transient population will return to their place of residence outside the 10-mile EPZ. Mecklenburg County, NC Emergency Management will coordinate evacuation of Carowinds.
 - 2. Winthrop University, in coordination with the York County Office of Emergency Management, has developed an evacuation plan to provide transportation for transport dependent students. The plan provides for notification of the faculty and student body, assembly areas, transportation and sheltering.

IV. CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

- A. The alert and notification of special facilities within the 10-mile EPZ of CNS will be made by York County Office of Emergency Management and the Charlotte-Mecklenburg County Emergency Management Office. State and local law enforcement officers from North and South Carolina will assist special facility security forces for crowd and traffic control.
- B. All requests from special facilities for additional resources will be made through the county EOCs.

C. Communications

1. Special facilities will be alerted by outdoor fixed sirens and tone activated signals from the York County EOC and NOAA Radio. Notification and updates will be made by telephone from EOC's to special facilities.

V. RESPONSIBILITIES


York County Office of Emergency Management

- D. Disseminates protective action recommendations issued by the government and/or the utility.
